Election calendar – the main events

In order to prepare for the by-election, and to promote the exercise of democracy, this newsletter contains the main dates on the electoral calendar. The public notice of election was published on April 9, 2024.

Commission of Revision of the list of electors Municipal office: 3-505, rue Frontière	Tuesday, May 14, 2024 10 am to 1 pm and Wednesday, May 15, 2024 2:30 pm to 5:30 pm and 7 pm to 10 pm	Any person who finds that they are not entered on the list of electors when they could be must, if they wish to exercise their right to vote, apply to the competent board of revisers for entry. Any person who finds that they are entered on the list of electors when they do not wish to be so entered, shall apply to the competent board of revisers for striking off. If they are domiciled within the territory of the municipality, they may request that their name be struck off the list solely for the purposes of a municipal election. Any person who finds that their name is entered on the list of electors in respect of a domicile, immovable or business establishment, when it should be in respect of another, must apply to the competent board for striking off the list, and if they wish to exercise their right to vote for entry on the list.
